She was awarded a PhD in law from the University of Cambridge which is the focus of her forthcoming monograph concerning the mass retention of communications metadata for law enforcement and national security purposes and European human rights law: <i>EU Data Privacy Law and Serious Crime: Data Retention and Policymaking</i> (Oxford University Press). Nóra is also co-author of the forthcoming textbook: Lynskey and Ni Loideain, <i>Data Protection Law and Policy</i> (Oxford University Press).</p> <p>Nóra is also a Visiting Lecturer in Law at King's College London in information privacy and data protection law and was previously an Affiliated Lecturer in Law of same at the University of Cambridge. She is an editor for the leading peer-review journal <i>International Data Privacy Law</i> (Oxford University Press) and was appointed a trustee of the British and Ireland Legal Information Institute (BAILII) in 2018.
